

# Transnational Project e-Meeting

Held via Skype on the 11<sup>th</sup> of February 2021 from 11 am to noon (CET)

After a brief welcome, the project partners discussed the following points:

#### - Finnish Local Webinar

HLU is planning to organise the Finnish local webinar on 26th of February 2021 with all local stakeholders.

#### - German Local Webinar

Due to the ongoing Covid restrictions, TUM will organise the local webinar at the end of the current German lockdown (foreseen on 7<sup>th</sup> of March) and by the 20<sup>th</sup> of March, so a possible date will be around the 15<sup>th</sup> of March 2021.

## - SPHERE Final Webinar

The final webinar of the project will be organised by EPSI on 26th March 2021 from 2 pm to 6 pm. During the next days, EPSI will circulate among all partners a draft of the agenda in order to allow all project partners to add considerations and contributions. EPSI will specify also what it needs from the partners (presentations, materials, a list of participants and stakeholders from each country, etc.).

# - EitC's Multiplier Sport Event

Due to the current Covid restrictions in the UK, EitC will not be able to organise an offline multiplier sport event by the end of the project (31st March 2021).

Johnathan Garside, supported by Sampsa Kivistö, proposed to adapt and deliver an online alternative for participants from across the European pilot sites to engage in a day of activities to support physical, social and mental wellbeing.

Garside has already sent a draft proposal for such alternative event.

As remarked during the call, it will be difficult to justify an online multiplier event (and during the coordinators' meeting held on February 9<sup>th</sup> the speakers highlighted various times such difficulty). ECOS will evaluate the proposal and give an answer as soon as possible.





## - Academic paper(s)

CMet and the Scientific Committee of SPHERE will meet online by the end of February (probably on February 26<sup>th</sup> at 11 am CET) to discuss the writing of one or two academic papers related to the project activities and outputs.

CMet has already prepared a first draft of a paper and will discuss it with all members of the scientific committee.

Because of the long process underlying the approval of an academic paper (evaluation, peer review, etc.), it will take months (or years) for the final release of the paper. Anyway the draft of the paper will be uploaded on the ECAS platform as further intellectual output.
